

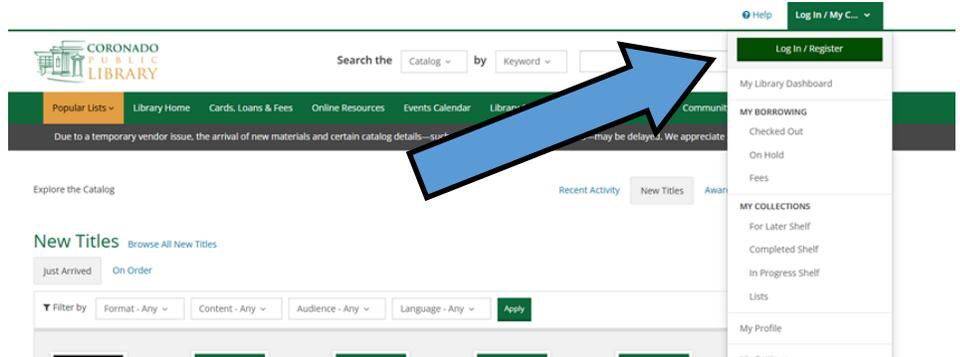


How to Save Your Borrowing History

When the Coronado Public Library transitions to a new catalog in mid-February, your borrowing history and for later shelves will not transfer with it. If you would like to save your this information for your own records, please follow the procedure below.

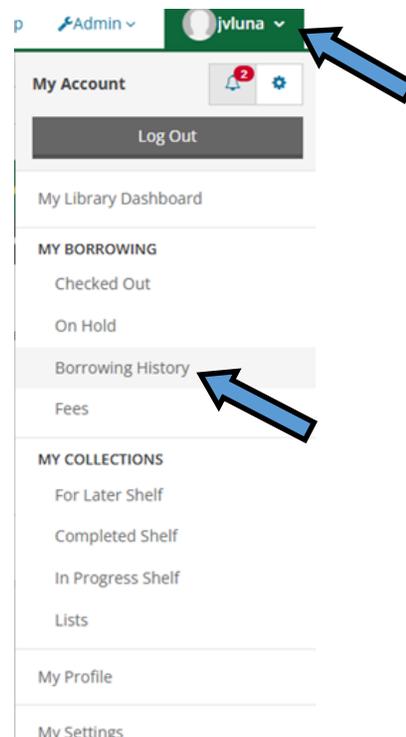
Borrowing history must have been opted in to for any items to show in your account.

1. Sign into the catalog at www.cplcatalog.org



2. Once you are signed in, click on the caret (▼) next to your username. A drop down menu will show.

Click on borrowing history.



3. Click the Print Icon

4. Click on “Print these 50.” A print dialog box should open up. From here, you can either print your list or save it as a PDF.

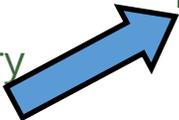
